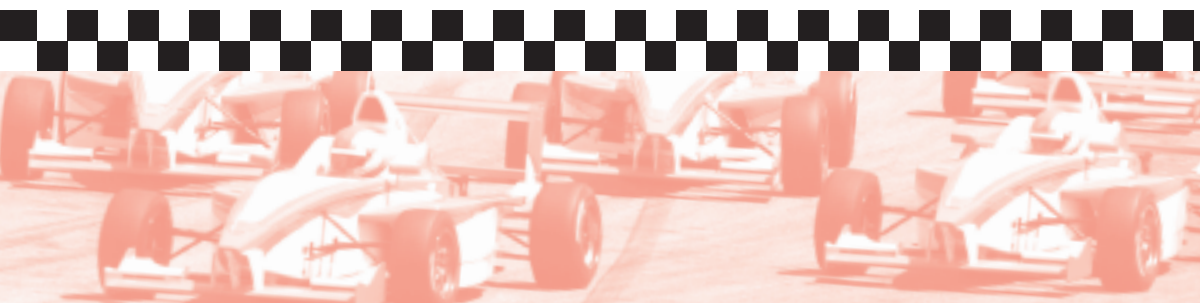

SHORE (Sheltering the Homeless is Our Responsibility) is an all-volunteer, interfaith, not-for-profit organization of individuals, churches, temples, business and civic groups in central Westchester which provides housing opportunities for people in need.

Grace Church Community Center, through a broad array of service programs from soup kitchen to home health services, carries out its mission to assist Westchester County’s neediest and most at-risk residents, especially those not served by other resources.

The Children’s Learning Center (formerly St. Bernard’s Center for Learning) helps children of families who are in shelters, as well as families who meet the low-income eligibility guidelines for Head Start and the Department of Social Services; also, services for children with special needs.

Housing Action Council offers technical assistance and extensive services to community-based not-for-profit organizations, public agencies and community-minded for-profit developers to produce and preserve affordable housing.
